
Subject: Rattle Noise from Passenger side Instrument Panel

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit a rattle noise from the passenger side instrument panel when driving on a rough road.

CAUSE

The bracket C on the passenger-side air bag and bracket holder on the instrument panel interfere and make a rattle noise when driving on a rough road.



The felt size and attaching point on the bracket holder have been changed.



REPAIR PROCEDURE

When you encounter a customer complaint on this concern, lightly tap the passenger side of dashboard. If the noise occurs, follow the procedure below to fix the concern.


Procedure

- 1. Remove the glove compartment.
 - Push the glove compartment end in the direction of the arrow (1) and remove hooks A.



Caution


When disengaging hooks A, the hooks could interfere with the lower panel and cause scratches or damage. When removing hooks A, press in the ends of the glove compartment to a location which does not interfere with the lower panel.




Pull the stay damper in the direction of the arrow (2) shown in the figure and remove the hook
 B.

Caution

If the glove compartment is closed without being joined to the stay damper, the stay damper may be damaged. Verify that the stay damper is joined to the glove compartment before closing the glove compartment.




• Pull down the glove compartment in the direction of the arrow (3).




 Pull the glove compartment in the direction of the arrow (4) and remove it while detaching hooks C.


- 2. Remove the nuts.
- 3. Place the Bluetooth unit beside.




- 4. Remove the fastener (glove box light harness).
- 5. Remove the screw and nut.
- 6. Remove bracket A.




7. Remove the nut.



8. Remove bracket C.




- 9. Select a sheet of pad in 0.25mm thickness from the "Noise Parts Set" and cut it to the following size.
 - · 9 pieces of 10 X 33 mm size



10. Attach the felts to the 3 location of Bracket C as below, and apply 3 pieces in layer at each location.





11. Install in the reverse order of removal.

Lightly tap the passenger side of dashboard and confirm the noise is disappeared.
