


PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

During PCM reprogramming, some vehicles may show some warning messages with flashing Start stop switch. This is caused by reset function of ABS/DSC CU not working properly.




Below warning messages are displayed.



REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Turn the IG-off by pushing Start Stop switch for long time (around 3 seconds) to turn off.
- 2. After that, disconnect **ABS/DSC S 30A** Fuse for 30 seconds so that the system is reset back to normal.



Note: There is similar name fuse "ABS/DSC M 50A, that's wrong one.
