## RX-8 Radiator Screen Pat No. 11805 Installation Instructions

## **Tools** Required:

10mm wrench 10mm socket & ratchet 12+" extension Phillips-head screwdriver

Completion Time: .5 hour - People required: 1

Note: If you are planning to remove the front bumper to install the Racing Beat oil cooler screens, you can install the radiator screen at the same time. Otherwise, we ecommend that you remove the undertray for access to the radiator area.

- 1. Remove the undertray (un's a the nose has been removed). Note: Not all of the fasteners need to be removed, just enough to place the screen into position, and access the air conditioning condenser (radiator) retaining bolts, see Photo A for locations of retaining fasteners. These fasteners as a combination of Philips head screws, plastic clips, and 10mm head bolts.
- 2. Remove only ONE of the four bolts that hold the condens. to the water radiator. Install one of the brackets, oriented as shown in Photo B. Do not fully tight in the retaining bolt, thereby allowing the bracket to be rotated slightly during the installation of the screen.
- 3. Repeat this process, also using the original bolts, for the remaining three (3) bolts one at a time. (This process prevents the cooler from falling out of position.)
- 4. Position the screen with the "Racing Beat" decal fac.. wward at the top of the screen. A screen with the four (4) supplied bolts. Before tighter and the screen is centered. Tighten all bolts to 72-96 in/lbf. See Photo C.
- 5. Check the clearance around the screen; there should be at least 1/2" clearance between the screen and any object. Adjust the screen if necessary.
- 6. Re-install the undertray.



C= 10mm Head bolts




