2004-2005 RX-8 RI4725 P0442, P0455, P0456 Set In PCM

Some vehicles may have DTC(s) P0442, P0455 or P0456 stored in PCM memory. Customers may also complain of long cranking time to engine start. This concern may be caused by a stuck open purge valve due to contamination of the upper intake manifold catch tank.

- 1. Verify concern.
- 2. Pinch off Leak Detection Pump (LDP) vent line.
- 3. Using K-LINE EVAP tester, check flow gauge for leaks.
- 4. If K-LINE indicates leak, fill EVAP system with smoke.
- 5. Remove hose connection from purge valve to intake manifold at intake manifold.
- If smoke comes from the purge valve, replace the extension manifold (upper). See Workshop manual section 01-13 INTAKE-AIR SYSTEM.
- If smoke does not come from purge valve hose, proceed with normal diagnosis. See Workshop manual section 01-02 TROUBLESHOOTING.
