

## MULTIPLE MODELS INFORMATION DISPLAY SEGMENTS FULL AFTER REMOTE ENGINE STARTING RISESO

Some customers may report after starting their vehicle with the Remote Engine Start Accessory and unlocking their vehicle, the information display is all filled in and will not reset unless the engine/ignition is turned off, then back on.

This concern is caused by the RES button or Unlock button on the keyless transmitter being pressed too many times after the engine is started. This causes the Information Display to enter a test-mode. Normally after the engine is started using the RES, pressing the RES or Unlock button will result in the following actions:

- 1X DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS
- 2X ALL DOORS (AND LIFTGATE IF EQUIPPED) WILL UNLOCK
- 3X INFORMATION DISPLAY ENTERS TEST MODE AND ALL DOORS (AND LIFTGATE IF EQUIPPED) WILL UNLOCK

To attempt to duplicate the condition using the Remote Engine Start, perform the following:

- 1. Double press the remote to start the vehicle (may be different for other models).
- 2. Just when the engine starts triple press the RES (or Unlock) button (as if you were attempting to unlock all 4 doors, but pressed the button 1 too many times).
- 3. The display will say LESE, followed by a few other messages, at the conclusion of which all the fields in the display will be filled in.
