

## MULTIPLE MODELS IPOD® ADAPTER APPLICATION TABLE

When an accessory iPod® adapter is used with an unsupported iPod, some functions (e.g. control audio volume) of the iPod® do not work. The iPod® application table lists supported and unsupported iPods by adapter.

When you encounter a customer complaint that the iPod® doesn't work correctly, check if the customer's iPod® is listed is compatible with the iPod® adapter. If not listed or if the iPod® has a dash "-" in the table, inform the customer that their iPod® is not supported and some functions will not work as stated above.
