MULTI-MODEL UNINTENDED AIR BAG DEPLOYMENT DURING VEHICLE SERVICE

When performing electrical repairs on a vehicle with the battery connected, be advised that the vehicle's air bag system is live. Any interference of the air bag system with a connected battery may cause an unintended air bag deployment.

Example:

If the vehicle's battery is connected and the SRS module is unbolted and tilted, the SRS module may interpret this as a vehicle roll-over. In this case, the SRS module may deploy the air bags.

Always disconnect the vehicle's battery and wait one minute or more before:

- Removing SRS air bag system-related parts.
- Performing any electrical repairs.
- Removing trim that requires electrical connector disconnect.
