Some vehicles may exhibit a seat that shakes back and forth and is noisy during braking.


Customers having these concerns should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

RX-8, Mazda5 & Mazda6 [with pantograph type seat lifter (A)]:

- 1. Verify customer complaint.
- 2. Install three (3) springs to the back of the seat cushion seat pan (C) and pipe frame (B).

NOTE: The shape of the spring varies depending on the seat type.



CX-7, CX-9 & Mazda3:

NOTE: The hooks of this type of spring vary depending on which side the hooks fit to.
