# Remote alarm/central locking

## **System operation**

- Pressing key remote transmitter UNLOCK button once unlocks driver's door.
- Pressing key remote transmitter UNLOCK button twice within 5 seconds unlocks all doors.
- If vehicle unlocked and doors or trunk/tailgate not opened within 30 seconds, locks/alarm are reactivated.

### **Programming**

#### When

Key remote transmitter added or replaced.

#### How


NOTE: A maximum of 3 key remote transmitters can be programmed.

· Obtain all key remote transmitters.


NOTE: Any existing key remote transmitters not used during programming will become inoperative.

- Remove key from ignition switch.
- Close all doors.
- Open driver's door.
- Carry out the following procedure within 24 seconds:
  - □ Turn ignition switch ON and back to LOCK position 3 times.
  - □ Remove key.
  - Press and release driver's door courtesy light switch 3 times.
  - □ Ensure doors lock and unlock.
  - □ If not, wait 40 seconds and repeat procedure starting with driver's door already open.
- Press any button of each key remote transmitter twice
- Ensure doors lock and unlock after each key remote transmitter operation.

- If not, proceed as follows:
  - Press and release driver's door courtesy light switch once.
  - □ Ensure doors lock and unlock twice.
  - Repeat procedure starting with driver's door already open.

#### **Immobilizer**

#### System operation

- System arms after switching ignition OFF.
- Start engine.
- Ensure immobilizer warning lamp illuminates briefly Fig. 24163.
- System malfunction present if:
  - □ Immobilizer warning lamp flashes rapidly.
  - □ Immobilizer warning lamp does not illuminate.
  - □ Immobilizer warning lamp remains illuminated.

#### **Programming**

#### When

Key added or replaced.

### How - with two or more programmed keys

NOTE: Complete each step within 30 seconds of previous step unless otherwise specified.

- Obtain all keys.
- Using first programmed key, proceed as follows:
  - □ Turn ignition switch ON and back to LOCK position, 5 times within 5 seconds.
  - □ Turn ignition switch ON.
  - Ensure immobilizer warning lamp illuminates
    Fig. 24163.
  - Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
  - Ensure immobilizer warning lamp extinguishes
    Fig. 24163.

- Using second programmed key, proceed as follows:
  - □ Start engine.
  - Check that immobilizer warning lamp illuminates for 1-2 seconds Fig. 24163.
  - □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
- Repeat procedure with first programmed key as follows:
  - □ Start engine.
  - □ Check that immobilizer warning lamp illuminates for 1-2 seconds **Fig. 24163**.
  - □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
- Using each new key, proceed as follows:
  - □ Start engine.
  - Check that immobilizer warning lamp illuminates for 1-2 seconds Fig. 24163.
- Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
- To exit programming mode: Wait 30 seconds.
- Confirm programming by starting vehicle using each key. Wait at least 5 seconds between keys.

NOTE: A maximum of 8 keys can be programmed.

#### How - with one or no programmed keys

NOTE: An 8 digit security code is required for this procedure; refer to dealer.

NOTE: Complete each step within 30 seconds of previous step unless otherwise specified.

- Using first new key, proceed as follows:
- Turn ignition switch ON and back to LOCK position 5 times within 5 seconds.
- □ Turn ignition switch ON.
- □ Check that immobilizer warning lamp flashes at 0.3 second intervals Fig. 24163.
- Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and wait 5 minutes until warning lamp flashes at 1.2 second intervals.
- The security code number can now be programmed as follows:
  - Turn ignition switch ON when the immobilizer warning lamp is not illuminated and count the same number of flashes indicated by the first digit of the security code.
  - □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position immediately after the immobilizer warning lamp extinguishes on the last counted flash.

- Turn ignition switch ON when the immobilizer warning lamp is not illuminated and count the same number of flashes indicated by the second digit of the security code.
- □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position immediately after the immobilizer warning lamp extinguishes on the last counted flash.
- □ Repeat the above procedure for remaining six digits of the security code.
- When all 8 digits are entered correctly the immobilizer warning lamp will stop flashing and remain illuminated.
- □ Start engine.
- Check that immobilizer warning lamp illuminates for 1-2 seconds Fig. 24163.
- □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
- Using second new key, proceed as follows:
  - □ Start engine.
  - Check that immobilizer warning lamp illuminates for 1-2 seconds Fig. 24163.
  - □ Turn ignition switch to LOCK position and remove key.
  - Repeat above procedure for remaining programmed and/or new key(s).
- To exit programming mode: Wait 30 seconds.

# NOTE: A maximum of 8 keys can be programmed.

 Confirm programming by starting vehicle using each key. Wait at least 5 seconds between keys.
