
Subject: Starter Motor Insulator Established

DESCRIPTION

Starter motor insulators have been established as a service part.


In order to reduce the clearance between the starter motor and the engine / transmission, an insulator is fitted on the starter motor.

This insulator prevents dust from entering the starter motor and also prevents premature deterioration on the starter motor. Therefore, if any damage is found on the insulator, be sure to replace it with a service part according to the following procedure.



Insulator Installation Procedure

- 1. Using a scraper or equivalent tool, completely remove the insulator from the starter motor.
- 2. Degrease the insulator installation location.
- 3. Peel the adhesive backing from the insulator, then affix the insulator onto the starter motor as follows.
