


⚠ WARNING


• When removing/installing the parts, park the vehicle on level ground and apply the side brake securely. Be sure to turn the ignition switch off, otherwise the vehicle can move, causing personal injury or vehicle damage.

⚠ CAUTION

• Tighten the shift knob by hand, not with a tool.

4 INSTALLATION





1. Remove the factory installed shift knob by rotating it in the direction of the arrow (counterclockwise).

⚠ CAUTION -

• The factory installed shift knob may be stiff to rotate. Rotate the shift knob slowly.

A shift knob is turned about 10 times.

2. Install the accessory shift knob by rotating it in the direction of the arrow (clockwise) about 10 rotations .

Torque begins to go up and the shift pattern marking is aligned parallel to the lateral center axis of the vehicle in the range of further 5-6 rotation.

⚠ CAUTION -

- Do not position the shift knob by rotating it counterclockwise, otherwise it could become loose.
- 3. Please clean a shift pattern label ② attachment position finely with neutral detergent etc.
- 4. The same shift pattern label ② as the shift pattern of vehicles is stuck.

⚠ CAUTION -

 Before sticking shift pattern label ②, please be sure to stick after degreasing with neutral detergent etc.
It will become the cause of peeling if it sticks by not degreasing.
